Thomas Gabor

He has also served as a consultant for 20 years to the United Nations, government agencies, law enforcement, correctional agencies, attorneys, and publishers. He has published more than 125 books, research reports, and scholarly articles. Dr. Gabor's research and publications have been covered widely in the media and have earned him a number of awards and honors. He is a member of the

Criminology Who's Who and the Canadian Who's Who.
